BUILDING BLOCKS NEWS

Here in Newfoundland, one of the questions frequently asked is "whaddya at?" To answer that question, here is Building Blocks News — a publication of Cornerstone Housing Society. Some of you may be wondering where we are in the process of becoming a L'Arche community and if we are making any progress. We are indeed making progress as we continue to lay down the building blocks of our organization. But we need the continued support both of our membership and wider interest group to ensure this dream becomes reality.

Our founding Board of Directors was elected at the first AGM held April 5, 2014. Board Members include Brian Dawe, David Buckley, Don Rowe, Evelyn Friesen, Jane Pippy, Lewis Andrews, Marilyn Bruce, Mel Friesen and Peter Barnes. At the inaugural meeting of the Board, the executive of the Board was formed with Evelyn Friesen, Chair; Lewis Andrews, Vice Chair; Don Rowe, Secretary; Mel Friesen, Treasurer. Additionally, Paul McCarthy has joined us in a consultative role as Accountant.

The Board meets the second Thursday of each month. Decisions made to this point have been primarily of an organizational nature.

- Ratified the by-laws
- Identified skills and interests of Board members for future committee work. Committees will include both Board and Society members.
- Signed a Conflict of Interest policy
- Decided to follow best practice of requiring Certificate of Conduct and Vulnerable Sector checks for Board members. In future those checks will be mandatory for employees and volunteers (including committee members) who have contact with core members.
- Met informally with Raphael Amato, former Community Leader with L'Arche Ottawa.
- Began work on a presentation package
- Worked with Jenn Power in developing a community mandate (more info below)
- Discussed timelines
- Decided that the minimum donation eligible to receive a tax receipt is \$20

FUNDRAISING



COMMUNITY MANDATE

On June 9th and 10th, and continuing on August 16th, the Board and other interested members met with Jenn Power, L'Arche Atlantic regional leader, to work on developing a community mandate, a required step for a L'Arche Community. This was an intense reflective process in which we had to examine ourselves, our motives, and our ideas as we identified what we believe is the call of Cornerstone Housing Society as we work to establish a L'Arche community in Newfoundland and Labrador. It was also a valuable exercise in coming together as a group to listen to each other and to grow in understanding. The community mandate will be the framework for our future, including (we anticipate with hope and faith) being named a "L'Arche Project."
